- How many pages your site will be?

How will it look?

Do you have branding/ logos/ color schemes that you want to use on your website?

Are there any websites that you really like? Or dislike?

- If so can you tell us what about them you like/dislike?

What would you like your URL to be? eg www.myURL.com do you prefer .com/ .net/ .ie?

· If your first choice were not available what other options would you like?

Will your site require frequent updating?

Other questions that may be useful?

Do you already have a website?

If so are you seeking a redesign or a new site?

Do you have a time frame or date that you want your website to go live?

Do you want a content management system (CMS*) that would allow the ability to do updates yourself?

Do you have existing e-mail? Would you like to use e-mail at your domain?

Would you like an estimate for us to perform updates and maintenance?
